2019 will bring the initial construction of a major multiple phase infrastructure project to the primary roadways, two rail trails, and a Town Center / Public Square Park within Coopersburg. Background

Coopersburg adopted a Comprehensive Plan (2010) and a Streetscape Plan (2015), recognizing and spelling out the need to reinvest in Coopersburg's infrastructure and future.



Purpose

- ✓ Calm (Slow) traffic on main thoroughfares
- ✓ Create safe and walkable, bicycling, drivable main thoroughfares, and accessible intersections
- ✓ Beautify and enhance our historic character
- ✓ Connectivity of residents with commercial, educational, historical and recreational assets
- ✓ Designate on-street parking on main thoroughfares

Coopersburg Streetscape & Rail Trail Plan

Improvements

On Main Street, East Station Avenue & West State Street:

- ✓ New curbs & ADA compliant sidewalks
- ✓ Texturized & ADA compliant intersection crosswalks
- ✓ Pedestrian Lighting
- ✓ Designated on-street parking
- ✓ Directional signage, benches, trash receptacles, etc.
- ✓ Bicycle Sharrows

Rail Trails

- ✓ Saucon from Landis St. to Bucks County line
- ✓ Liberty Bell Trolley from W. State St. to Linden St.

Town Center / Public Square Park on East side of Main Street at State Street

Funding Sources

- ✓ Funded primarily with State grants (approximately 70%)
- ✓ Coopersburg share (approximately 30%) WILL NOT increase local Real Estate taxes
- ✓ NO individual property owner contribution required
- ✓ Construction conducted in phases as grants come available and awarded
