Regular Meeting Minutes November 17, 2020

The meeting of the Coopersburg Borough Council was held on Tuesday, November 17th, in Council Chambers at Borough Hall & called to order by Council President Balascak at 7:00 p.m.

OPENING CEREMONIES

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call was taken by Manager Paashaus. All present were Mayor Hovis, Council Members Balascak, Dietz, Ellenberger, Kane, Poot, Solicitor Capehart, & Engineer Erdman. Council Members Craig & Thrapp were absent.
