
STREETSCAPE PURPOSE

 Educational, Historical & Recreational Assets
- Designate On Street Parking on Main
 Thoroughfares




CONDITIONS OF COST

Funding / Schedule

- Funding: Federal Transportation Alternatives Program Grant (\$1,000,000)
- Schedule
 - Design Summer/Fall 2023
 - Bidding Winter 2023
 - Construction Spring/Summer 2024
 - Duration: estimated 4-6 months
 - Minor lane closures / road restrictions required
